## A & B DIVISION SCORING INSTRUCTIONS

Each game in best 2 out of 3 matches are worth (one half)  $\frac{1}{2}$  point. For example, if Smith/Jones are playing Black/Brown in a 501 doubles match and Smith/Jones win the first leg, they receive (one half)  $\frac{1}{2}$  point. Suppose then that Black/Brown win leg 2, they also receive (one half)  $\frac{1}{2}$  point. Leg 3 goes to Smith/Jones, thereby increasing their point total for that match to 1 point.

On your score sheet, it would look like this:

501	Smith	1	1/2	Black	501
	Jones			Brown	

If Smith/Jones had won 2 straight legs, Black/Brown would not have received any points. It would look like this on your score sheet:

501	Smith	1	0	Black	501
	Jones			Brown	

These are the only 2 possible point combinations you should have on your score sheet. Hopefully, this system will result in a more accurate reflection of the way the matches of A & B Divisions were played.

A few reminders:

- 1) Do *not* mark the score till that particular match is over.
- 2) *Write* the score - do not make X's in the box.
- 3) Be sure to *total* your score correctly.
- 4) The Team game is worth 1 point because it is only one game.
